IMPORTANT PROGRAM INFORMATION: Please read before submitting this form.

The OLPH Confirmation Program is a one year program and does not approach formation through a traditional classroom style model. Our goal is to invite the teens to develop and grow in an authentic relationship with God that lasts a lifetime and does NOT end with the night of the Confirmation Mass. Below is a breakdown of the program.

It allows for communication directly to their phones, between the teens, their peers and their Confirmation Leaders, without having to pass along private phone numbers to anyone outside of the Youth Office. This is also our communication platform to parents.
